File taken up today on an application moved by applicant/petitioner Parveen @ Parveen Kumar seeking pre-mature encashment of his FDRs.

Present : Sh. Dharmender Kumar, Ld. counsel for
applicant/petitioner with applicant in person.

Heard on the application. Record perused.

The applicant is seeking pre-mature encashment of his FDRs on the ground of repayment of loan taken by him for the marriage of his sister which has already been solemnized on 12.03.2026. It is argued by Ld. Counsel for applicant that applicant wants to start his business to earn his livelihood.

Vide award dated 20.04.2019, an award for a total sum of Rs. 14,37,600/- was passed in favour of petitioner and against the respondent/insurance company. It may be noted here that vide said award, out of the total awarded amount, a sum of Rs. 3,50,000/- was directed to be immediately released to the applicant/petitioner and remaining amount was directed to be kept in FDR of Rs. 10,000/- each for a period of one month, two months, three months and so on and so forth, having cumulative interest).

Report from the concerned bank received. Same is perused.

Taking into consideration the submissions made and in the facts and circumstances, Manager, SBI Rohini Courts Branch is directed to release only a sum of Rs. 7,00,000/- to the applicant/petitioner out of remaining compensation amount lying

with the bank, on completing necessary formalities, as per rules.
Application stands disposed of accordingly.
