The present appeal is directed against the judgment dated 10.02.2026 and order on sentence dated 16.02.2026 passed by the Court of Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi, in a case titled as “Shri Rajeev Kumar Versus Manoj Sharma & Ors.” bearing CC No.1883/2016, whereby the appellant Saroj has been convicted and sentenced for the offence punishable u/s 138 N.I. Act.

Along with the present appeal, the appellant has moved an application u/s 430 BNSS (earlier Section 389 Cr.PC) for suspension of the sentence and grant of bail till the disposal of the present appeal. It is stated that the appellant has remained on bail during the course of trial. Arguable points have been raised in the appeal. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, **the sentence awarded to the appellant by the Ld. Trial Court vide order on sentence dated 16.02.2026, is suspended subject to deposit of 25% of the fine/compensation amount as awarded by the Ld. Trial Court in the form of a bank draft in the name of the**

respondent within a period of two weeks from today and the appellant is granted bail till the final disposal of the present appeal on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Link JMFC/Duty JMFC within seven working days.

Issue notice of the appeal to the respondent on filing of PF/RC within 7 working days, for **29.04.2026**. TCR be also summoned for the next date of hearing. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. Counsel for the appellant, as prayed and be also sent to the Ld. Trial Court for information.
