

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN SPL(C) MA NO. 224/2014

This is the bail petition filed by applicant as per Sec.439 of Cr. P. C.

2] The say of applicant is that complaint is lodged by Akshada Bhagat alleging that on 20-5-2014 applicant was doing construction work in the temple. That time he claimed water to Pratiksha and when she provided water to him, he misbehaved with her as narrated in the complaint. The say of applicant is that he did nothing and he is in jail since 20-5-2014. According to him, he did nothing and, therefore, bail should be granted.

3] State appeared and objected the application.

4] I heard the submissions of both the sides.

5] After perusal of police papers, I found that accused misbehaved with complainant in the temple under the pretext of obtaining water from her. His act is such that life of small Pratiksha aged 6 years came in danger. It is true that no any external injuries were noted on her private part or on her body, but act done by applicant is such that it caused bad impact on her considering her age. I have perused the police papers and I found that still investigation is going on. So when investigation is going on, it is not proper to release the applicant on bail. So I say that application is not tenable and is liable to be rejected. With this, I reject the application and pass the following order.

ORDER

Application stands rejected.
