1. The Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff has moved an application under Order VII Rule 14(3) r/w under Section 151 CPC 1908, to place on record certain additional documents. The advance copy of the application is already supplied to the Ld. Counsels appearing for the defendants. Let the reply, if any, be filed within two weeks from today, alongwith an advance copy to the other side.

2. The plaintiff has also filed the list of witnesses and the evidence affidavit of his first witness. The advance copy of the affidavit is also supplied to the Ld. Counsels for the defendants.

3. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff that he wishes to press the application seeking additional documents to be brought on record, prior to leading the evidence of the plaintiff. Heard. Allowed.

4. It is pointed out by the Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 1 that the copy of the document which the plaintiff is seeking to rely upon in the present application is not legible. Perusal of the record reflects that the plaintiff is seeking to place on record a whatsapp chat wherein purportedly newspaper article was shared by defendant no. 1 to the whatsapp number of the plaintiff and in the said document, the entire newspaper article is not legible besides the heading.

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5. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff that the plaintiff has received the said whatsapp message 'as it is' and he is not relying upon the entire contents of the newspaper article besides the heading, which is legible in the document filed before this Court and the copy is supplied to the other side.

6. Let the reply to the aforesaid application be filed within time granted.
