Today the case was fixed for preliminary evidence of complainant. Preliminary evidence of complainant has been recorded and AR for complainant has closed the preliminary evidence vide his separately recorded statement.

As per the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in case titled as *Sanjabij Tari Vs. Kishore S. Borcar & Anr. Crl. Appeal No. 1755 of 2010 dated 25.09.2025*, it has been held by the Hon'ble Apex Court that no pre-summoning notice is required as per section 223 of BNSS in complaint filed under Section 138 of NI Act.

Therefore the requirement of serving notice upon the accused is no longer necessary under Section 223 of BNSS.

Now, the case is adjourned to **13.08.2026** for consideration on the point of summoning of accused.
