File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Kishan.**

Present: Sh. J. S. Malik, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Ghanshyam (**physically**) and Sh. Narender Sharma (**through VC**), Ld. Counsels for complainant alongwith complainant in person.
Sh. Vineet Jain, Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused appearing **through VC**.
IO/Inspector Satvinder Singh in person.

Reply to the above said application has already been filed by IO.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 19.06.2025 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that a bare perusal of the alleged statement of the complainant, it is the complainant and deceased/victim, was the persons, who were the aggressor and provoked the other persons, as there is no intention or any over act on the part of accused person and there is no evidence or record that any alleged conspiracy has been hatched between the applicant/accused and other co-accused persons to execute the alleged crime. It is further submitted that nothing incriminating have been recovered from the possession of applicant/accused or at his instance rather the alleged recovery

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has been planted upon him. It is further submitted that investigation of the present case is completed and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation. It is further submitted that no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 04.06.2026 charges for the offences punishable U/s. 103(1) / 115(2)/118(1)/238/3(5) BNS has been framed against applicant/accused **Kishan** and his co-accused persons with the allegations that applicant/accused **Kishan** alongwith his co-accused persons, in furtherance of their common intention, committed murder of Bobby Singh @ Piyush. Perusal of the

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record also shows that applicant/accused **Kishan** and his co-accused persons voluntarily caused hurt to complainant Jitender @ Ajay and Surya and also voluntarily caused hurt to Surya using a knife. As per the reply of IO, applicant/accused **Kishan** and his co-accused persons actively participated in the commission of the alleged offence and as per CCTV Footage applicant/accused **Kishan** participating in the assault and also depict co-accused Vishal and Yashu @ Sanata immediately after the incident carrying knives. Perusal of the record shows that present case is at the stage of evidence and eye/material witnesses are yet to be examined. Possibility of threat to victim/eye witnesses cannot be ruled out, if applicant/accused **Kishan** is released on bail at this stage.

Keeping in view of the above discussion and also considering the severity and the gravity of offence as well as seriousness of allegations, the present bail application of applicant/accused **Kishan** is hereby dismissed.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties. The present bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
