File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Dinesh**.

Reply to the bail application has been filed.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. She has further submitted that applicant /accused is in JC for a considerable time period i.e. for more than two years. She has further submitted that injured/victim has already been examined. Ld. counsel further submitted that applicant/accused has clean antecedents. She has further submitted that Mahender is not residing there, he is residing at Allahabad. She has thus prayed for grant of bail to the applicant/accused.

On the other hand, ld Additional P.P for State had strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that the offence is serious in nature. Hence, the application of applicant/accused may be dismissed.

Heard.

Keeping in view the overall facts and circumstances, custody period and the fact that material witness/injured has already been examined and trial will long time to conclude, it is ordered that applicant/ accused be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond

in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount. He is further directed not to threaten the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or indulge in any such crime. The applicant/accused shall share his phone's live location as and when required by the IO. The bail application is disposed off accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
