Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused is seeking interim bail for the applicant/accused on the ground that she is critically ill since 22/04/2021, she is unable to properly walk or take food due to shortage of breath and her oxygen saturation level has come to dangerous level and there is very scarce supply of oxygen to her vital organs, jail authorities after feeling the emergency removed her to DDU hospital but due to non-availability of bed and shortage of oxygen, she could not be admitted, life of the applicant is under imminent threat.

On the aforesaid submission of Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused medical status report of applicant/accused was called. As per report of Medical Officer, Central Jail 06 Dispensary, Tihar, new Delhi, the applicant/accused is a follow-up case of defecation/bilateral knee pain. It is further mentioned that on 22/04/2021, she complained of cough, cold and sore throat and her Rapid Antigen Test was done in CJ-06 dispensary and she was found to be positive for COVID-19 with mild disease, she did not give any history of loss of smell or loss of taste & was kept in isolation and provided medical care as per protocol inside the jail. It is further mentioned that on 26/04/2021, she complained of bodyache, weakness and breathing difficulty and on examination, her SPO2 was fluctuating between 90-92%, primary treatment was given, was referred to GTB hospital for further management, where she was examined and her SPO2 was 96%, was prescribed necessary medicines (as already prescribed in CJ-06 dispensary) and advised for isolation in jail and was kept in isolation in jail. It is further mentioned that at present, the applicant/accused has been managed inside the jail and provided best medical care as per protocol, is under regular follow-up of doctor and in case of any emergency, she will be referred to COVID-19 dedicated government hospital, her vitals are stable and she is on necessary medication for COVID-19 as per protocol.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State has submitted that since the applicant/accused is getting proper treatment in hospital and her condition is stable, there is no need to grant anticipatory bail to her.

Heard. Keeping in view the aforesaid report of concerned Medical Officer that proper treatment & medication is being given to the applicant/accused qua COVID-19, also in view of the fact that her condition is stable and she is under regular follow up of jail dispensary doctor and further keeping in view the fact that applicant/accused is suffering from COVID-19, it will not be prudent to release her on interim bail as there is possibility that her family members may get affected through her, the present bail application for grant of interim bail is dismissed and is disposed of accordingly.

It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused that the present case is pending before the Court of Ms. Smita Garg, Id. ASJ, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi. He has further submitted that present applicant/accused is is aged about 37 years, is suffering from injury on back which was earlier caused by gunshot and the same had been treated at Saroj hospital since December, 2018 till his arrest. He has further submitted that applicant/accused is also having regular check-up and treatment by the Tihar Jail authorities at Saroj Hospital while being on interim bail. He has further submitted that applicant/accused has again started suffering from pain and acute weakness and start having problem in walking and his condition has worsened for the last 7-8 days and doctors at Tihar Jail are unable to give proper treatment to him as due to present situation of COVID-19 pandemic, which may also lead to internal infection to him as the pain at this stage is becoming uncontrollable and condition of the applicant/accused is not stable. He has further submitted that applicant/accused is pursuing his medical treatment at Saroj Hospital Institute and there is only a slight enhancement in the condition of the applicant/accused, doctor has advised him to have total bed rest and is in need of proper care and treatment for about a month. He has also submitted that earlier also, the applicant/accused was granted interim bail on various occasions and he surrendered after expiry of interim bail period. He has further submitted that applicant/accused is seeking interim bail for a period of 45 days to enable him to get proper medical treatment and care, as such he may be released on interim bail.

Dr. Neeraj Kumar Garg, Medical Officer, Central Jail no.1, Tihar, has submitted that applicant/accused is admitted in jail hospital with high degree fever and his oxygen level has dipped. He has further submitted that applicant/accused is having numbness due to gunshot injury and if not

taken care of properly, the same can be dangerous to the applicant/accused. He has further submitted that applicant/accused needs appropriate and regular physiotherapy. He has further submitted that presently, physiotherapy is not possible in jail.

On the other hand, Id. Addl. PP for the State has objected to the grant of interim bail to the applicant/accused.

Heard. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission of Medical officer of Tihar Jail that applicant/accused is having high grade fever, his oxygen level has dipped, is suffering from numbness due to gunshot injury and if not treated properly, it could be dangerous for him, is in need of regular physiotherapy & also in view of the fact that he needs proper care and further medical treatment for his said ailment, **the applicant/accused is ordered to be released on interim bail for 10 days on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Jail Superintendent.** However, the applicant/accused is directed not to indulge in any such crime or tamper with evidence or influence the prosecution witnesses and to follow the guidelines qua COVID 19 issued by Government of India as well as by Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The applicant shall share his phone live location as and when required by the IO. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the Court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the interim bail granted to him shall be liable to be cancelled. **The bail application is disposed of accordingly, with liberty to move fresh application in case the applicant/accused needs further medical treatment and care.**

He has further submitted that complainant is trying to implicate the applicant in a false and fabricated case and the applicant has given many complaints against the complainant before the police station as well as higher authority and on this, the complainant has lodged this FIR against him. He has further submitted that complainant wants to grab the property bearing no. Khasra no. 161/2 (16-12), Village Mukundpur, Delhi as the applicant is the caretaker of the said property. He has further submitted main allegation of tearing of clothes of the complainant is against co-accused Sahil and not against this applicant. He has further submitted that civil case is pending between the parties. He has further submitted that applicant is a young married person, police officials of PS Bhalswa Dairy has regularly visited the house of the applicant, hence there is every apprehension in the mind of the applicant that he may be arrested in the present false and fabricated case. He has further submitted that applicant is ready to join the investigation as and when required and directed by the court, is ready to furnish relevant surety bond before IO/SHO in case anticipatory bail is granted and undertakes to abide by any terms and conditions imposed upon him. He has lastly prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant/accused.

On the other hand, Id. Addl. PP for the State has objected to the grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant on the ground that statement of complainant u/s 164 Cr.P.C. was also recorded, section 394 IPC was also added, the applicant/accused is absconding and his NBW has been issued.

Heard. Keeping in view the seriousness of the offences, also in view of the fact that statement of complainant/victim has also been recorded u/s 164 Cr.P.C. and also in view of the fact
