As per latest order of Hon'ble High Court vide no. 5/R/RG/DHC/2021 dated 23/04/2021 & order no. 6/R/RG/DHC/2021 dated 14/05/2021 & subsequent to partial modification of order No. 16756-16818/Judl/North/RC/2021 dated 15/05/2021 vide order No. 18626-18680/Judl/North/RC/2021 dated 02.06.2021 of Id. Principal District & Sessions Judges, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi, all judicial officers of Delhi District Court shall take-up only urgent cases of their respective Courts, through videoconferencing from 04/06/2021 till 30/06/2021 and all other matters shall be adjourned en bloc and information in this regard shall be uploaded on the website(s) of Delhi District Courts.

This application for grant of interim bail u/s 439 Cr.P.C. moved on behalf of applicant/accused is **Sandeep @ Choti** placed before me in terms of order No.Judl./Bail/North/RC/2021/18756-18780,dated 02.06.2021 of Id. Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi. The same is taken-up through videoconferencing via CISCO Webex App.

Reply from the DCP concerned has been received. Same be placed on record. It is submitted by Id counsel that he is seeking interim bail of the applicant/accused on the basis of latest guidelines of H.P.C of Hon'ble Delhi High Court. He has further submitted that applicant is in JC since 18.03.2019. Id. Counsel has further submitted that applicant/accused is ready to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by the Court in case he is granted bail by this Court.

Report from the concerned Jail Superintendent has been received. As per the report applicant was admitted in JC on 21.03.2019 and was released on interim bail on 19.10.2020. It is further reported that he again re-admitted on 02.03.2021 and his total custody period is 01 year, 10 months and 11 days. As per the criteria of H.P.C guidelines the required custody period of the applicant is insufficient. Further last year the applicant was granted bail on the medical ground of his wife and not as per the guidelines of H.P.C, hence some clarifications is required in this regard.
