File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Amit @Mitti @Miti**.

Reply to the above said application has been filed by IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 02.02.2026 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that nothing is recovered from the possession of the applicant/accused, if any, the same is planted. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is doing a labour work and he is sole bread earner of his family. It is further submitted that investigation of the present case has already been completed and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation. It is further submitted that no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

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On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 627/2025 has been registered at PS S. P. Badli U/s. 309(4)/317(2)/3(5) BNS. It is important to mention that complainant has failed to identify applicant/accused **Amit @ Mitti @Miti** as one of the offender during Test Identification Parade conducted before Ld. JMFC concerned. Recovery has already been effected and no further custodial interrogation is required. Applicant/accused **Amit @ Mitti @ Miti** is in JC since 02.02.2026. Investigation qua him has been completed. Chargesheet has been filed. Trial shall take time. Therefore, it is ordered that applicant/accused **Amit @ Mitti @ Miti** be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 20,000/- with one surety** in the like amount **subject to the satisfaction of following conditions:-**

(i) Applicant/accused is directed not to threaten prosecution

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witnesses in any manner or tamper with evidence or indulge in any other criminal activity in future;

(ii) Applicant/accused shall not commit similar offences in future. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the Court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the bail granted to him shall be liable to be cancelled on an application of investigating agency in this regard.

The bail application is disposed of accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case. Application stands disposed of. Bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
