This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru. P. Panthalarajkumar learned Advocate for the petitioners and of Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, learned Public Prosecutor for the State and after hearing the arguments and perused records, this court passed the following...

ORDER

Petition filed U/s. 439 Cr.P.C. Petitioners/Accused prays to enlarge them on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 399 IPC in Cr.No.492/2022 of Tiruvannamalai East police station. The petitioners/accused were remanded on 26.09.2022

The learned counsel for the Petitioners/Accused stated that they are an innocent person and not in anyway connected with the above alleged offences, that the investigation is almost over, that they are having residential address with valuable properties, that the question of absconding or tampering the witness will not arise, that they will abide any condition if imposed by this court in the bail order, that they were remanded on 26.09.2022 and they are in custody for 16 days and they prays for bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor for the State has vehemently raised objection for granting bail to the petitioners/accused stating that the petitioners/accused making preparation to commit dacoity. However he has conceded that no previous case is pending against the petitioners/accused.

Heard Both sides. Records perused. The case was registered against the petitioners/accused for the offences punishable u/s. 399 IPC. The case of the prosecution was that the petitioners/accused making preparation to commit dacoity. Considering the fact that no previous case is pending against the petitioners/accused as stated by the learned Public Prosecutor and on considering the period of incarceration and upon considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court inclines to grant bail to the Petitioners/accused with stringent conditions.

Bail is granted to the petitioners/accused on Strict compliance of the following conditions.

1.The petitioners/accused are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/-each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned Judicial Magistrate, No.II Tiruvannamalai.**

2. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police station daily at 10.00 am. for a continuous period of 30 days.

3. The petitioner/accused shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

4. The petitioner/accused shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
