File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain**.

Present: Ms. Geeta Bansiwala, Ld. Substitute Addl. PP for the State.
Ms. Shivali Gautam and Ms. Vishali Gautam, Ld. counsels for applicant/accused.
IO/Inspector Chander Shekhar in person.

Reply to the above said application has already been received from IO.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 22.04.2022 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that there is no single eye witness in the present matter who can establish the presence of applicant/accused at scene of crime. It is further submitted that there is no recovery of mobile phones from applicant/accused which showed connectivity or conspiracy in the accused persons and long incarceration in jail has already been caused severe psychological as well as physical harm to the innocent applicant/accused. It is further submitted that present case is at the stage of evidence and total 22 witnesses in the list of prosecution witnesses and the important witnesses have been examined. It is further submitted that trial will take a long time and no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bar. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly

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opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Perusal of the file shows that vide order dated 06.10.2022 charge against applicant/accused has been framed for the offence punishable U/s. 302 IPC with the allegations that applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain** committed murder of Rakesh S/o. Sh. Vishesar Sahni by causing multiple injuries with blunt object on his head and other parts of his body. It has come in the testimony of one of the material witness that applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain** was last seen fighting with deceased over the food/roti given by deceased to applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain**.

Keeping in view of the above discussion as well as in view of seriousness of offence for which applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain** has been charged, this court is not inclined to allow the present bail application of applicant/accused **Alamveer Hussain**. Same is disposed off, accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. **Copy of order be given dasti to the**

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concerned parties. The present bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
