ORDER

In view of National Lok Adalath this case is suo-moto advanced to today 11.02.2025. A1 and A2 are present. Complainant/Lw.1-Jadhav Vikram is present. Court constable-Prem Singh is present. Lw1 is stated in the petition that he intends to compromise the case with the Accused persons. Heard, on both sides. Further, the learned APP filed petition U/sec. 321 Cr.P.C. to withdraw the offence U/sec. 294(b)

IPC, on account of compromise between the parties. Hence, petition is allowed. Perused the material on record, the offence punishable U/sec. 323, 506 IPC is compoundable, U/sec. 320(1) of Cr.P.C. Therefore, in the circumstances set out in the petition and in the interest of justice, permission is granted to compromise the matter as both parties voluntarily came forward to compromise the case. Compromise is recorded. In the result the award is passed in terms of settlement in turn in between the parties. As Lw1 and Accused persons are compromised, the matter U/sec. 320(2) Cr.P.C., this petition is allowed and Accused persons are acquitted for the offence U/sec. 323,506 IPC and their bail bonds if any, shall stand cancelled.
