This is the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of the applicant/accused Deepshubham.

1. This is an application under Section 439 CrPC for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused Deepshubham on the two grounds, one for school admission to twin daughters of the applicant/accused and second for medical ground of the mother of the applicant/accused.

2. Verification report has been filed by IO. Copy supplied.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused has argued that he is seeking interim bail of the applicant on the two grounds, one for school admission to twin daughters of the applicant/accused and second for medical ground of the mother of the applicant/accused. It is further submitted that applicant/accused will not flout any terms and conditions, if so imposed. It is prayed that a lenient view be taken.

4. Ld. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the interim bail application stating that applicant/accused should not be granted interim bail owing to the gravity of the offence.

5. I have heard the submissions made by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State and Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused.

6. As regards the medical condition of the mother of the applicant/accused it is reported by the IO that there is also brother and father of the applicant/accused who can take care. However, as regards the grounds of school admission of twin daughters of the accused, it is verified that the accused does not have Aadhar Card of Delhi and necessary documents are required for their admission.

7. Taking a lenient view on humanitarian ground, **accused Deepshubham is granted interim bail for a period of 15 days from the date of his release on his furnishing of bail bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety of the like amount, who is permanent resident of Delhi/NCR, to the satisfaction of the Court/Duty MM/Area MM** but subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The applicant/accused shall not try to contact or influence the witnesses in any manner, directly or indirectly.
- (b) The accused shall not indulge into similar offence in the event of release on bail.
- (c) The accused shall not tamper with the evidence.
- (d) The accused shall provide his mobile number to the concerned SHO, on which he may be contacted, if required as per law and shall ensure that the said number be kept active and switched on all the time.
- (e) The accused shall surrender himself before the concerned Jail Authorities after expiry the period of interim bail.

Application is disposed off accordingly.

7. *It is clarified that nothing stated herein shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.*

8. Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused as well as be sent to concerned IO, concerned Jail Superintendent, Ld. Secretary, DLSA (North), through all possible modes, as per rules, by the court staff.
