*This suit came before me for final hearing in the presence of **M/s. P. Rekha Rani, Counsel for Plaintiffs** and of **Defendant Nos.1 and 2** are set **exparte** and upon having hearing the and on perusal of the material on record and the matter having stood over for consideration till this day, the court delivered the following:*

:: JUDGMENT ::

1. This suit is filed by the plaintiffs for the relief of declaration to declare the plaintiff as the legal heirs of deceased D.H. Usha Rani W/o. Late D.H. Manjunath who died on 03.11.2025.

The brief averments of the plaint are as follows:

2. The plaintiffs filed the present plaint by stating that the plaintiff is the daughter of deceased D.H. Usha Rani who died on 03.11.2025 and the father of the plaintiff namely D.H. Manjunath also died on 21.12.2002 leaving behind the plaintiff as her legal heirs. The plaintiff is the successor,

legal representatives and surviving legal heir of the late D.H. Usha Rani W/o. D.H. Manjunath no other legal representatives, successors, legal heirs are alive. After death of D.H. Usha Rani, the plaintiff approached the defendant No.1 on 23.02.2026 to obtain legal heir certificate, but they refused to issue the same and advised the plaintiffs to approach the competent court. As such, the plaintiff filed this suit.

3. The defendant No.1 did not appear before the court inspite of service of summons and hence defendant No.1 was set exparte. No objections received for the paper publication and hence defendant No. 2 was set exparte.

4. During the course of plaintiffs' evidence, Plaintiff was examined as PW-1 and Exs.A1 to A4 got marked.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the plaintiff. Perused the material on record.

6. Now the point for determination is ***"whether the suit can be decreed as prayed for"***?

POINT:

7. The plaintiff examined as PW1 and filed chief affidavit in lieu of her chief-examination wherein she has reiterated the averments of the plaint. She got marked the death certificate of the deceased D.H. Usha Rani as Ex.A1, which shows that she died on 03.11.2025. Ex.A3 death certificate of D.H.Manjunath, which shows that he died on 21.12.2002. Further, Ex.A4 would support the case of the plaintiff as regards her relationship with the deceased D.H. Usha Rani. Thus, from the oral evidence of PW-1 and the

documents Exs.A1 to A4 the plaintiffs could prove their case about the relationship with D.H. Usha Rani. This evidence stood unrebutted and unchallenged. Therefore, the plaintiffs are entitled to be declared as legal heirs of Late D.H. Usha Rani. The point is answered accordingly.

8. In the result, the suit is decreed, without costs, declaring that plaintiff is the legal heir of Late D.H. Usha Rani W/o. D.H. Manjunath for the purpose of legal status only.
