1. A fresh civil suit has been received by way of entrustment. The report of reader has been perused, and the suit is found to be in order. Accordingly, it is directed that the suit be registered and assigned a case number.

2. Along with the main suit, an application under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC has been filed by the plaintiff, seeking interim relief.

3. In view of the urgency involved in the suit, let summons be issued to the defendants for their appearance and filing of a written statement for **12.08.2026** on filing of PF, copies of plaint etc.. The plaintiff is at liberty to take RC/dasti summons. The process-serving agency is directed to ensure timely service of summons upon the defendants. In the event that the summons cannot be served upon the defendants through ordinary means, the process server shall proceed with affixation of summons as per Order V Rule 17 CPC. A copy of the summons shall be affixed at a conspicuous place at the defendant's last known residence or place of business, and a report shall be submitted detailing the manner in which the affixation was carried out.

4. Further, in compliance with Order VII Rule 14 CPC, the plaintiff is directed to supply copies of all documents relied upon in the plaint, ensuring that they are duly furnished by the next date of hearing.
