File has been taken up today on the bail application of the accused Shibu.

Present:- Sh. S.K. Tripathi, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Manish Garg, Ld. Counsel for the accused.
IO/SI Anshul in person.

Reply of the application has been filed.

Counsel for the accused has submitted that no other bail application of the accused is pending either before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi or before any other court; that the accused is in custody since 14.01.2026; that the accused was in jail when the offence was committed; that earlier the accused was on bail and was regularly appearing before the court and unfortunately, he could not appear before the court on 15.09.2025 and an NBW was issued against him; that in execution of the NBW, the accused was arrested; that witnesses have not supported the case of prosecution and that no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody and thus, he may be admitted to bail.

Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP for the State opposed the present application submitting that since the dismissal of the earlier bail application of the accused, circumstances have not changed and if the accused is released on bail, he would again stop appearing before the court and delay the trial.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

In the instant case, due to the absence of the accused on 15.12.2025, an NBW was issued against him and on 15.01.2026, he was produced after being arrested on 14.01.2026.

In earlier orders, vide which the bail applications of the accused were dismissed, it is categorically observed that HC Vikas, who had arrested the accused submitted that while he was arresting the accused, the accused had inflicted several injuries on his head with some sharp edged weapon, which could not been recovered because the accused had thrown the same on the spot and he was in a hurry to rush the accused to the hospital.

It was also observed therein that the conduct of the accused raises an apprehension that if the accused is released on bail, he would again stop appearing before the court and may commit any offence, if he required to be arrested in compliance of the process of the court.

Therefore, since the dismissal of the earlier bail application of the accused vide order dated 30.05.2026, circumstances have not changed.

Accordingly, this court is not inclined to admit the accused Shibu to bail and the application stands dismissed.
