COMMITAL ORDER



The Police Inspector of Hennur Police station, Bengaluru has submitted this charge-sheet against the accused persons for the offences punishable U/s 143 of BNS-2023 and U/sec.3,4,5,6,7,9 of ITP Act .

2. The brief facts of the case of the prosecution is that :-

On 17/02/2025 at about 11:10 PM, at building No. 302, H.N.R. Residency Apartment, 3rd Floor, Flat No. 302, situated behind Chalikere Government School, within the jurisdiction of Hennur Police Station, Bengaluru City, the accused were residing on rent. Acting on credible information, the police, along with panch witnesses, conducted a raid and found the accused persons indulging in prostitution by using women who were victims of human trafficking. The victim women were rescued by the complainant police. The investigation revealed that the accused were running a



brothel, earning income from prostitution, and exploiting the victim women as slaves for the purpose of prostitution, thereby committing the alleged offences. Hence, this charge sheet.

3. The accused Nos. 1 and 2 were arrested and later remanded to judicial custody. Subsequently, they were enlarged on regular bail pursuant to the order passed by the Hon'ble 45th Addl., City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bengaluru (CCH-46) in CrI.Misc. No.1511/2025 and accused are represented by their counsel.

4. The charge-sheet and other prosecution papers have been furnished to the accused No.1 and 2 through their counsel as contemplated U/s 230 of BNSS-2023.

5. Perused the charge-sheet and other prosecution papers filed by the investigation officer. The prosecution papers disclose that the alleged offence 143 of BNS-2023 and U/sec.3,4,5,6,7,9 of ITP Act. It appears to me that,



alleged offence against the accused Nos.1 & 2 U/s 143 of BNS, which is exclusively triable before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions. The prosecution papers, at this stage has made out a prima-facie case against the accused No.1 & 2 for the alleged offences. As alleged offence is exclusively triable before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, it is just and necessary to commit the case to court of sessions for trial. Accordingly, this court proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

A) Acting u/S.232 of BNSS-2023., the case against the accused No.1& 2 is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at Bengaluru for trial.

B) Office is directed to notify the committal order to the Learned Public Prosecutor of the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at Bengaluru.

C) Office is hereby directed to submit entire case file and properties if any to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at the earliest.

D) The accused No.1 & 2 are hereby directed to appear before Hon'ble District and Sessions Court whenever called upon

to do so soon after receipt of
intimation.
