ANTICIPATORY BAIL APPLICATION U/S 438 CR.P.C.

ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of anticipatory bail application filed by applicant/accused in case bearing FIR No.128 dated 29.11.2017 under sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act, P.S. Badhnikalan.

2. Notice of this bail application was given to the State and Sh. Amandeep Prinja, Addl. APP has appeared on behalf of the State.

3. ASI Sewak Singh, No.698/Moga P.S. Badhnikalan Investigating Officer of the present case has come present and stated that recovery of the present has been effected from the co-accused Charanjit Kaur and she disclosed that she had brought the contraband from present applicant-accused Rano, so the custodial interrogation of the applicant-accused is required.

4. Heard. Police record perused. As per FIR, co-accused Charanjit

Kaur was apprehended by the police and a recovery of 90 tablets of Alprazolam X.L Pam 0.5 has been effected. The present applicant-accused has been nominated later on the statement of co-accused Charanjit Kaur. Recovery in the present case has already been effected and now nothing is to be recovered from present applicant-accused. As such, this Court is of the view no custodial interrogation of the applicant-accused is required. Moreover, the applicant-accused is ready to join the investigation.

5. As such, the applicant-accused Rano shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 09.02.2018 at 11:00 A.M. sharp and thereafter as and when directed by the investigating agency. She will fully co-operate with the investigation of the present case and in the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer. The accused-applicant shall abide by the terms as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Copy of this order be sent to the SHO/IO concerned for information and necessary compliance.

7. Now case is adjourned to 16.02.2018 for awaiting report of IO/SHO concerned.
