Offender not appeared. Despite several attempts at issuance of notices, the same could not be served. It is difficult for this court to proceed with the present case on account of failure of the state/service agency to serve the notices/summons upon the accused. Further attempts in issuing notices/summons shall lead to exorbitant expenditure on the exchequer. The efforts put in to apprehend the accused should be commensurate with the offence alleged to be committed by him. Since the accused is not appearing before the court despite the issuance of the notices/summons to procure his presence; this court does not find it judicious to keep this challan pending. Accordingly, the proceeding in present challan are hereby stopped under Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The accused is hereby discharged in absentia. Challan, along with all the original documents, be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
