This is an application u/s 483 of the BNSS for grant of interim bail filed on behalf of the accused Raju.

Arguments heard.

It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the accused/ applicant that the present application is being moved without touching of the case on merits. It is submitted that the marriage of the first cousin of the accused/applicant is to be solemnized on 19.06.2026 in which the presence of the accused /applicant is imminent, more so there is no one else responsible in the family to look after the affairs of the marriage. It is prayed that for such purpose, the accused/ applicant be admitted to interim bail for a period of 20 days. It is prayed that the application be allowed.

Per contra, Id. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application citing the seriousness of the allegations and gravity of the offence. It is submitted that the accused/applicant played a pivotal role in the commission of the offence. It is submitted that there are clinching evidence against the accused/applicant and if enlarge on bail, he may abscond or threaten the witnesses. It is prayed that the bail application be dismissed.

Considered.

The factum of the marriage, scheduled to be solemnized has been verified. Though, as per reply filed by the IO, there are several adult members in the family, still the place of the accused/applicant cannot be replaced/fulfilled by them. One of the co-accused has been granted regular bail.

As such, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, in particular, to enable the accused/ applicant to the marriage of his cousin, the application is allowed to the extent that Accused/ applicant Raju @ Rishi is admitted to interim bail for a period of 20 days from today on furnishing of personal bond in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- and one surety of the like amount.

The accused shall abide by the following conditions:

- i) Accused shall not flee from the justice;*
- ii) Accused shall not tamper with the evidence;*
- iii) Accused shall not threaten or contact in any manner to the prosecution witnesses;*
- iv) Accused shall convey any change of address immediately to the SHO/IO and the Court;*
- v) Accused shall also provide his mobile number to the Court and SHO/IO.*
- vi) Accused shall keep his such mobile 'Switch On' at all the time;*
- vii) Accused shall not indulge in any kind of criminal activities;*
- viii) Accused shall surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately after expiry of interim bail period i.e. at 10:00 AM on 27.06.2026.*

Application stands disposed off.

Copy of this order be also sent to the accused through concerned Jail Superintendent and also to SHO/IO concerned for information.
