Case taken up today before the Bench of National Lok Adalat.

Vide separate statement already recorded on 05.01.2023, the learned counsel for the complainant has stated that the accused has paid full and final payment and that he intends to withdraw the present complaint.

In view of the above statement, the Bench of Lok Adalat is satisfied that there are sufficient grounds to allow the compounding of the offence as the complainant has been duly compensated. It is also a fit case for waiving of the compounding fee. In view thereof, the offence punishable under Section 138 of NIA alleged against the accused stands compounded. The accused accordingly stands acquitted of the offence under Section 138 of NIA. Bonds furnished by the accused are cancelled and surety (if any) stands discharged. Award be prepared accordingly and the statement of the complainant Ext.P-1 shall form part of the award so prepared. File, after due completion, be consigned to record room.
