- 1. Whether the counter claimant is entitled to a money decree for a sum of Rs. 59,37,213/- lacs in his favour and against the non-counter-claimant, as prayed for? OPCC***
- 2. Whether the counter-claimant is entitled to interest, if yes, at what rate and for what period? OPCC***
- 3. Whether the suit for the counter claimant is not properly valued and appropriate court fees has not been fixed? OPNCC***

4. Relief.

No other issues are pressed for by the parties. Nor does any other issue arise from the pleadings of the parties.

The counter claimant is directed to file evidence by way of affidavit along with list of witnesses within 15 days from today with advance copy to the Counsel for the non counter claimant.
