St. Vs. Charandeep Singh

Heard. Police record received. As per version of prosecution, on 13.4.2018 when complainant Vikramjit Singh reached circuit house, Ludhiana, one vehicle stopped in front of his vehicle, so he also stopped his vehicle. The window pane of right side of his vehicle was open. Charandeep Singh Channu and Gurmukh Singh Raja tossed his turban. Raja took out key of his vehicle and tried to pull him out after catching him from his hair. Gurmukh Singh pulled his beard. They were having some sharp object with which they gave him blows. The accused also tried to snatch Sri Sahib and threw turban and gave foot blows to the turban which is disrespect to his Karrars. When passers-by started gathering, Gurmukh Singh and Charandeep Singh Channi ran away after snatching his gold chain.

In the present case, applicant Charandeep Singh Channi had also moved an application on 13.4.2018 for loss of gold chain in the scuffle with complainant. Civil litigation is also stated to be pending between the parties. Father of complainant also moved an application with the police but he did not say that gold chain of complainant was stolen. So without discussing the merit of the case at this stage this court is of the opinion that applicants be allowed to join the investigation with the police. Accordingly applicants Charandeep Singh @ Channi and Gurmukh Singh are directed to join the investigation with the police and

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in the event of their arrest, the applicants are ordered to be released on interim bail by the Investigating/Arresting officer to his own satisfaction subject to the conditions enshrined in section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Bail application be put up on 16.5.2018 for arguments. Police file returned and same be again produced on next date.
