File taken up today on an application u/s 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail moved on behalf of the applicant/accused Bhim Singh.

Reply to the bail application has been filed by the IO.
Copy of the same is supplied.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused that he has falsely implicated in the present case and the accused is in JC since 25.03.2024 and he further submitted that investigation has been completed and chargesheet has been filed by the IO on 20.06.2024 and in the FIR there was no role of applicant/accused mentioned. He further submitted that accused has been victimized and all allegations are false and baseless and he(accused) is ready to submit himself to any condition/conditions, which the court may impose to allay the fears of the prosecution of any kind of likely absence from the trial. It is prayed that the present bail application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, ld Additional P.P for State had opposed the bail application and submitted that applicant/accused is actively involved in the alleged offence and he was present at

the time of commission of the offence therefore the present application may kindly be dismissed.

Submission heard. Record perused.

Briefly stated, present FIR has been registered for the offences punishable u/s **498A//304B/302/34 IPC and & 4 Dowry Act and** there are allegations that the deceased was murdered by her husband on the instigation/abatement of present applicant/accused Bhim Singh and other co-accused persons. Keeping in view of the seriousness of allegations against applicant/accused as well as after considering the seriousness of the alleged offences, no ground of bail is made out. The present bail application is **dismissed** and same is disposed of accordingly. Bail application file be consigned to record room. Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties.
