

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.01

The present application is filed for issuance of heirship certificate under the provisions of Bombay Regulation Act. The deceased Shaikh Khadar S/o Shaikh Baba died on 01.05.2021, at Parbhani. It is contended by the applicants No.1 Halima Begum W/o Shaikh Khadar, No.2 Shaikh Saleem S/o Shaikh Khadar and No.3 Shaikh Javed S/o Shaikh Khadar that they are the legal heir of deceased Shaikh Khadar S/o Shaikh Baba. Now the applicants are in need of legal heirship certificate for legal recognition.

2. The public notice given in the local newspaper in “Dainik Deshonnati” dated 23.12.2022 it is at Exh.16 Public notice is also issued. It appears that, nobody appeared to resist the application for grant of heirship certificate in the name of present applicants, within stipulated period.

3. The applicants in support of their application adduced the evidence of applicant No.2 at Exh.10 and closed the evidence by filing pursis at Exh.17. The applicant filed on record verified copy of death certificate of deceased Shaikh Khadar S/o Shaikh Baba at Exh.11, verified copies of aadhar cards of applicants and deceased at Exh.12 to 15. The application and the evidence adduced, in support of the application, remained unchallenged. Consequently, it is held that the applicants being the surviving legal heirs of deceased Shaikh Khadar S/o Shaikh Baba is entitled to receive the heirship certificate, as prayed in application. The heirship certificate does not confer any rights in

applicant regarding the property of the deceased except the legal recognition as heir of deceased. In the result, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] Issue heirship certificate in favour of applicant on payment of requisite Court Fee, as prayed.
- 3] Dictated and pronounced in open Court.
