As offence under which FIR is registered are non-bailable and serious in nature. FIR has been registered under section 5, 3, 8 (1) The Punjab Prohibition of COW Slaughter Act, 1995. Therefore, in view of the gravity of offence involve in the FIR and circumstances of the present case, this court is of the view that at this stage the present application is entitled for the benefit of bail. Accordingly, the application is hereby dismissed. Paper be attached with the remand papers.
