These are second applications U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicants/accused persons namely **Sachin & Ajay** are placed before me in terms of order No. 18230-18256 Judl /Bail /North /RC /2026, dated 30.04.2026 of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi.

Separate reply to the above said applications has been received from IO. Same are taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicants/accused persons.

Ld. Counsel for applicants/accused persons submits that applicants/accused persons are in JC since 05.03.2026 and they have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that on the day of incident police officials were drunken due to festival of holi and he forcefully entered in the house of applicants/accused persons and started abusing without any reason and start beating the applicants/accused persons and the family members of applicants/accused persons. It is further submitted that police official who is the complainant in the present FIR enter the houses of the applicants/accused persons

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forcefully and without any warrant of arrest and without the warrant for entering the house and the police official misuse the power. It is further submitted that there is no independent eye witness to the alleged incident and the entire prosecution case rests solely upon the complainant's statement which is yet to be tested during trial. It is further submitted that alleged arrest of the applicants/accused persons have been shown by police officials only and the place of arrest is public area but there is no eye witness of the arrest. It is further submitted that alleged recovery has been effected in the presence of police officials and complainant only and no independent public witness was joined despite availability. It is further submitted that trial will take a long time and no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed. On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations

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against the applicants/accused persons are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said applications may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 97/2026 has been registered at PS Swaroop Nagar U/s. 221/132/121(2)/3(5) BNS with the allegations that applicants/accused persons namely **Sachin & Ajay** alongwith their co-accused persons, in furtherance of their common intention, obstructed public servant i.e. Ct. Lakshay in discharge of his public functions, assaulted, used criminal force and severally beaten him while performing official duties. As per the MLC of victim i.e. Ct. Lakshay the injuries sustained by him are opined to be grievous in nature. IO has informed that incident was captured in CCTV Camera wherein applicants/accused persons namely **Sachin & Ajay** are seen obstructing Police Constable Lakshay and causing injuries to him. It is also important to mention that vide order dated 08.05.2026 bail applications of applicants/accused persons have been dismissed and no change of any material circumstance has taken place since then.

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Keeping in view of the above discussion and also considering the severity and the gravity of offence as well as seriousness of allegations, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to applicants/accused persons namely **Sachin & Ajay**. The bail applications of applicants/accused persons namely **Sachin & Ajay** are dismissed, accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties. The present bail application files be consigned to record room.
