From the record it is evident that the defendant had already filed the written statement, list of documents with documents, affidavit of admission and denial of documents along with an application under Order VIII Rule 1 read with Section 151 CPC seeking condonation of delay in filing the written statement.
2. Ld. Counsel for the defendant submits that there is a delay of 15 to 17 days delay in filing the written statement.
3. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that he does not wish to file any reply to the aforesaid application of the defendant and he has no objection if the said application is allowed.

9. Thereafter, file be taken up for arguments on the aforesaid application of the plaintiff seeking permission to place on record certain documents and also for settlement of issues on **10.08.2026**.
10. Date has been given absolutely as per the convenience of Ld. Counsels of both the parties.
