Present : Sh. Binay Kumar, AR for complainant company.
Accused in person (**copy of aadhar card filed**).

Today, matter is listed for arguments on the point of notice.

Bail application not filed.

With the intervention of the court, both the parties have settle the civil liability for a total sum of Rs. 1,36,000/- to be paid by the accused in 3 EMIs i.e. first installment of Rs. 46,000/- and second and third installment of Rs. 45,000/- each payable on or before 26th of each English Calender Month, commencing from May, 2026.

Statement of AR for the complainant company as well as accused to this effect recorded separately.

At this stage, accused submits that he also wants to plead guilty with further submission to take lenient view against her.

Accused is duly warned about the legal consequences of his plea of guilt and he has been informed that he may be convicted on the basis of his plea of guilt. He has been given time to think over again and to consult his counsel but he has insisted to plead guilty to the offence committed by him.

After making necessary enquiry from the accused, the court is satisfied that the accused has voluntarily pleaded guilty to the offence committed by him.

It is prayed by accused that benefit of Probation Act be given to him and he be released on probation.

Separate statement of accused regarding plea of guilt also recorded.

Let notice be issued to the SHO concerned for filing report regarding previous conviction/ involvement report of the accused and report from the concerned Probation officer be also called for the next date of hearing.

List the matter for payment as well as filing report on 26.05.2026.
