File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Joginder.**

Reply to the above said application has already been received from IO.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that application is being moved on extremely urgent family and humanitarian grounds as the daughter of applicant/accused is approximately 24 years of age and her marriage alliance is required to be finalised. Being the father and natural guardian of the daughter, the applicant/accused is under a legal, moral, social and emotional obligation to perform the responsibilities connected with the marriage of his daughter. It is further submitted the presence of the applicant/accused is absolutely indispensable for conducting negotiations with the prospective family, arranging finances, meeting relatives, performing customary obligations and making necessary preparations relating to the proposed marriage of his daughter. It is further

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submitted that in the absence of the applicant/accused, the family is facing severe social and emotional hardship. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

The present interim bail application has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Joginder** on the ground of conducting negotiations for marriage alliance of his daughter, arranging finances etc., however, there are other members of family and relatives, who are capable of doing the same and as such there is no urgency for granting interim bail. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail to applicant/accused **Joginder**. Interim bail application is dismissed accordingly.

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Keeping in view of the above discussion, this Court is not inclined to allow the present interim bail application filed on behalf of applicant/accused **Joginder**. Same is dismissed accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. **Copy of order be given dasti to the applicant/accused.** The present interim bail application along with the proceedings be tagged with the main case file.
