ORDER BELOW EXH.01(Passed on this 02nd July, 2026)

Applicant has filed this application for grant of anticipatory bail under section 482 of B.N.S.S.

02. Perused application, say filed by the learned APP (Exh.11) and say of informant and victim at Exhs.9 & 10. Heard learned advocate Mr. D.E. Mane appearing for the applicant and learned APP Mr. Kurdukar.

03. The informant is mother of the victim girl who was 11 yrs. old in the year 2023. The applicant was friend of informant's husband. The applicant introduced himself as a doctor. It is alleged that on 10 April 2023 at about 3 PM to 4 PM the accused came to the informant's house and he inappropriately touched her breast and lower back. When the informant questioned the applicant about his conduct, he told her that the victim is growing girl and her checkup is necessary. The informant told said fact to her mother-in-law. She thought that the applicant, being a doctor, would have examined the victim girl. Therefore, she did not tell said incident to her husband. Later on the informant's husband murdered. As the informant was under mental trauma due to death of her husband, she neglected the act of the applicant. After recovering from her trauma, she filed first information report against the applicant on 25.05.2026.

04. Notice of this application is given to the victim. She filed her reply at Exh.10 and objected the application on the ground that if the applicant is released on bail, there is threat to her life. He may pressurize the victim and her family. Therefore, the victim prayed that application be rejected.

05. Learned advocate Mr.D.A.Mane submitted on behalf of the applicant that the informant had filed this false FIR after delay of three years. The accused was granted bail by learned JMFC Court, Solapur on the day on which the informant filed the first information report in present crime. The informant's family has filed various complaints against the applicant. After release of the accused on bail, the informant filed false FIR to harass the applicant and to keep him in the custody. There is no need of custodial interrogation of the applicant. Therefore, learned advocate for the applicant prayed for allowing present application.

06. Per contra learned prosecutor submitted that specific allegations are made against the applicant. The offence is of serious nature. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the applicant is necessary. The applicant has criminal antecedents. If he is released on bail, he may tamper with prosecution evidence. Therefore, learned prosecutor prayed for rejection of the application.

07. I have gone through the record. The incident occurred on 10.04.2023. But the FIR is filed after three years. It is alleged that, the applicant inappropriately touched the breast and lower back of the victim. Considering the delay in filing the FIR, possibility of false implication of the applicant cannot be ruled out. Nothing is to be recovered or discovered at the instance of the applicant. Offence levelled against the applicant

is not punishable with imprisonment for more than seven years. Purpose of the investigation can be served by giving appropriate direction to the applicant. Under such circumstances and for the reasons mentioned above, in my opinion, the applicant is entitled for anticipatory bail. Consequently, this application deserves to be allowed. Observations made herein above are for the purpose of deciding present application only. In the result, I pass the following order.

ORDER

01. The application is allowed.
02. Interim pre-arrest bail order dated 03.06.2026 is hereby confirmed.
03. The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court.
04. The applicant shall attend concerned police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer till the filing of the charge sheet.
05. Violation of any above condition may entail a ground for cancellation of bail forthwith.
06. Inform concerned police station accordingly.
