File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Raju** for performing all formalities ceremonies, rites and customs in his sister's.

Reply to the above said application received from the IO. Same is taken on record.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submitted that marriage of the sister namely Ms. Priya of the applicant/accused is fixed for 22.05.2023 at his native village i.e. Jogiya Math, Distt. Samstipur, Bihar and presence of applicant/accused is very necessary to perform the rituals being a brother as he is the only brother. It is prayed that the above said application of applicant/accused may be granted.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is further submitted that marriage of the sister of applicant/accused is solemnized at his native village i.e out of station and if the bail is granted to applicant/accused there are chances he may jump the bail. It is prayed that abovesaid application may be dismissed.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that if the bail is granted to applicant/accused he will provide the local sureties.

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Heard.

Keeping in view of the fact that documents have been verified by the IO and also considering the fact that his presence is required for rituals of marriage of his sister, on humanitarian ground the present applicant/accused be released on interim bail for a period of one week i.e. 20.05.2023 to 26.05.2023 on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 35,000/- with two local sureties in the like amount. However, he is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent after the expiry of interim bail. He is further directed not to threaten the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or indulge in any such crime. The applicant/accused shall share his phone's live location as and when required by the IO. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the interim bail granted to him shall be liable to be canceled . The interim bail application is disposed off accordingly. Interim bail application file be tagged with the main case file. Copy of the order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent. Copy of this order be given dasti.
