File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for grant of interim bail for a period of 15 days moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Shankar**.

Reply to the above said application has been received from IO. Same is taken on record.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that marriage of sister of applicant/accused will be performed on 01.02.2024 and applicant/accused is the real brother. It is further submitted that she has filed the marriage card alongwith the application. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State opposed the above said application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said

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application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

IO was directed to verify the factum of marriage as well as details of family members etc. IO has filed report wherein it is mentioned that marriage of real sister of applicant/accused is fixed for 01.02.2024. Further, IO has also filed the statements of father and neighbours of applicant/accused in this respect, therefore, on humanitarian ground **interim bail of applicant/accused is allowed for a period of three days w.e.f 31.01.2024 to 02.02.2024 on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 35,000/- with two sureties in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-**

- (i) Applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent after the expiry of interim bail.
- (ii) Applicant/accused is further directed not to threaten the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or indulge in any such crime.
- (iii) Applicant/accused shall share his phone's live location as and when required by the IO. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the interim bail granted to him shall be liable to be

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canceled.

The present application is disposed off accordingly. Present application file be tagged with the main case file. **Copy of the order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent. Copy of this order be given dasti.**
