File taken up today on an application for extension of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Ankit Dudhiya**.

Reply to the above said application has been filed by IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that vide order dated 29.03.2025 this Hon'ble Court granted the interim bail for a period of one week to applicant/accused on the medical ground of applicant/accused. It is further submitted that applicant/accused could not under go his surgery in this week due to continuous public holidays. It is further submitted that the relevant doctors in the Govt. Hospitals were on leave and the private hospitals were also faced with same situation. It is further submitted that applicant/accused has undergone medical examinations on 14.04.2025 and is advised by the doctors in St. Stephens Hospital for further examination on 15.04.2025 for the surgery. It is further submitted that today he has also filed the photocopy of medical documents of applicant/accused. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the above said application and submitted that allegations

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against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Keeping in view of the fact that applicant/accused has been advised for surgery on 25.04.2025 and he has to undergo various tests/investigations for the said purpose, therefore on humanitarian ground interim bail of applicant/accused is extended for ten days i.e. till 26.04.2025, on the same terms and conditions as prescribed in order dated 29.03.2025. **Applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent after 26.04.2025.**

It is made clear that in the eventuality of postponement of surgery, applicant/accused shall immediately surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent. A copy of this order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent and be given dasti to Ld. counsel for applicant/accused.
