It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicants /sureties that both the applicants / sureties namely Ms. Sumitra and Rajesh had stood surety to accused Shankar. It is further submitted that at the time of granting the interim bail of the accused Shankar, both the applicants / sureties namely Ms. Sumitra and Rajesh have furnished surety documents for the accused i.e., original FDR bearing No.42641766723 amounting to Rs.35,000/- issued by State Bank of India, Jahangir Puri, Delhi of applicant Ms. Sumitra and original RC of vehicle bearing No.DL10SS7250 of applicant Sh. Rajesh and the same are lying in the judicial file. It is further submitted that accused Shankar has already surrendered before the jail authorities. In view of the same, no useful purpose shall be served by keeping the aforementioned original FDR and RC of above-named sureties on record. Therefore, it is prayed that the present application may kindly be allowed.

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Submissions Heard. Record Perused.

Perusal of the record shows that accused Shankar has already surrendered before the jail authorities. Accordingly, no purpose shall be served by keeping the afore-mentioned FDR and RC on judicial record.

Accordingly, let original FDR bearing No.42641766723 amounting to Rs.35,000/- issued by State Bank of India, Jahangir Puri, Delhi of applicant Ms. Sumitra and original RC of vehicle bearing No.DL10SS7250 of applicant Sh. Rajesh be released to them against due acknowledgment as per law. One self attested copy of the same be retained on record.

Application is disposed off, accordingly.
