ORDER BELOW EXH.1

The plaintiff and his Ld. Advocate Shri. N.V. Nandagawali and the defendant along with his Ld. Advocate P.D. Tembhurne are present before the court today. As their appeared elements of settlement between the parties, the case was referred for mediation. As per the report of Ld. Mediator Judge at Exh.23, the case is amicably settled between the parties. It appears that the plaintiff and the defendants have settled the case as per pursis at Exh.22. I have verified the contents of the same from the parties, over which they stated that amicable settlement has been arrived between them as they are relatives of each other and they do not want to continue with the case. It appears that the said pursis has been signed by the parties and their respective Ld. Advocates. I found that the terms and conditions are voluntarily incorporated by the parties. I also verified from the party that they do not want to further contest the proceedings as amicable settlement is arrived between them as per Exh.23. In view of these facts and the report at Exh.23, the case is disposed of as compromise. Hence, I passed the following order :-

1. The RCS NO. 62/2022 is disposed off as compromised.
2. Decree be drawn accordingly.
3. Parties to bear their own costs .
4. Court fees be refunded to the plaintiff as per rules.
