

**Bail Matters 1151/2026**  
**PARSHANT Vs. STATE**  
**FIR No. 754/2025**  
**PS Bawana**

**U/s. 309(4)/311/3(5) BNS & U/s. 25/54/59 Arms Act.**  
**03.07.2026**

This is second application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of second regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Parshant @ Parashant @ Parshant Sherawat** has been received by way of transfer and also the order of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 29.12.2025 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that FIR has been lodged with unexplained delay, which creates a serious dent in the prosecution version and clearly indicates afterthought, embellishment and deliberation. It is further submitted that complainant could neither identify nor note down the number of the motorcycle allegedly used in the incident and the implication of the applicant/accused is based substantially upon disclosure statements allegedly made by co-accused persons. It is further submitted that no TIP of the applicant/accused was conducted despite the complainant not knowing the accused persons previously and the absence of TIP seriously weakens the prosecution case at this stage. It is further

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submitted that chargesheet in the present case has already been filed and applicant/accused is no more required for custodial interrogation. It is further submitted that no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 754/2025 has been registered at PS Bawana U/s. 309(4)/311/317(2)/3(5)BNS & U/s. 25/54 Arms Act. Applicant/accused **Parshant @ Parashant @ Parshant Sherawat** is in JC since 29.12.2025 i.e. for a period of six months. Trial shall take time. Co-accused Vinay has already been enlarged on bail, therefore, on the ground of parity with the above named co-accused, it is ordered that applicant/accused

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**Parshant @ Parashant @ Parshant Sherawat** be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the satisfaction of **Ld. JMFC/Ld.Link JMFC/Ld. Duty JMFC** as well as following conditions:-

- (i) Applicant/accused is directed not to threaten prosecution witnesses in any manner or tamper with evidence or indulge in any other criminal activity in future;
- (ii) Applicant/accused shall not commit similar offences in future. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the Court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the bail granted to him shall be liable to be cancelled on an application of investigating agency in this regard.

The bail application is disposed of accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Application stands disposed of. Bail application file be consigned to record room. Copy of the order be given dasti.
