ORDER:

1. Vide this order, I will dispose of the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C filed by accused/applicant Aman Rani @ Amandeep Kaur in the afore mentioned case.
2. The facts in brief of this case as are clear from the record are that on 21.07.2023, the bail applicant Aman Rani @ Amandeep Kaur along with co-accused was arrested by concerned police in possession of 20 Kg of poppy husk, without holding any valid permit or license in this regard.
3. Notice of the bail application was given to the State and concerned police record was also summoned. No reply to the bail application was filed on behalf of State. However, the bail application has

been strongly opposed by learned APP for the State.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant/accused as well as learned APP for the State and have perused the record.

5. Learned counsel for the accused argued that accused has been falsely implicated in this case and nothing has been recovered from her and that she is in custody since long and as such she may be granted bail.

6. On the other hand, Learned APP for the State submitted that accused has committed a serious offence under NDPS Act and thus his bail application may be dismissed.

7. As mentioned above, the police record depicts that the applicant/accused was apprehended in conscious possession of 20 Kg poppy husk, without any license or permit in this regard. As per police record, the FSL report has not still been received. The alleged recovery falls within the scope of non-commercial category. The accused/applicant is in custody since 21.07.2023. The presentation and disposal of challan is going to take considerable time and no fruitful purpose is to be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody further. Indefinite pre trial custody does not subserve the ends of justice. Accordingly, the bail application is admitted and the accused/applicant Aman Rani @ Amandeep Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:

1. That accused/applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence and will not offer any threat, promise or inducement, directly or indirectly to any of the person

acquainted with the facts of the case, dissuading him from disclosing the same to the court/ investigating agency; and

2. That accused/applicant will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the court.
3. That accused/applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing. Subject to the order of exemption, trial court is at liberty to cancel the bail order.

8. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Bail application file be tagged with main case file.
