ORDER:

1. The present regular bail application has been moved on behalf of applicants-accused Gurtej Singh and Balvir Singh for offence under Section 306 IPC by virtue of Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Notice of this bail application has been given to the State.

3. As per allegations, complainant Karnail Singh is agriculturist. He was having two sons namely Sandeep Singh and Manpreet Singh. Manpreet was married to Jasvir Kaur about 6 years back. Manpreet Singh was also agriculturist. That Manpreet Singh and his brother-in-law Gurtej Singh had jointly purchased one combine and they jointly worked with that combine during season time. Later on Manpreet Singh and his brother-in-law Gurtej Singh had sold old combine and they had purchased new combine jointly before harvesting of wheat crop last year and down payment for that combine was given by Manpreet Singh. While Gurtej Singh obtained loan qua his share from bank and he also got registered that combine in his name. Manpreet Singh and Gurtej Singh used that combine during harvest season of wheat crop but Gurtej Singh had not cleared accounts with Manpreet Singh and because of that, dispute occurred. Accused Jasvir Kaur wife of Manpreet Singh, Gurtej Singh brother-in-law of Manpreet Singh, Balbir Singh father-in-law and Baljinder Kaur mother-in-law of Manpreet Singh started creating trouble to Manpreet Singh. Jasvir Kaur even left the company of Manpreet Singh and she had gone to her parental house. About one month back, she had come back to her matrimonial house. Manpreet Singh kept on demanding the amount of his share qua harvesting of wheat crop, but his in-laws family members refused to that and they used to insult Manpreet Singh time and again and because of that Manpreet Singh used to remain under tension and being harassed from her wife Jasvir Kaur, brother-in-law

Gurtej Singh, father-in-law Balvir Singh and mother-in-law Baljinder Kaur, he had consumed some poisonous medicine, which was lying in the room so existed in the fields. Manpreet Singh was taken to Naresh Hospital Barnala and from that hospital he was referred to DMS Ludhiana and in that hospital at Ludhiana, Manpreet Singh has died at about 4.00 p.m. on 27.07.2022.

4. It may be submitted at the very outset that there are serious allegations against accused persons including applicants-accused Gurtej Singh and Balvir Singh brother-in-law and father-in-law of late Manpreet Singh that they used to harass Manpreet Singh and they used to insult him time and again, when he was demanding his money qua harvest season of wheat crop and because of that he has committed suicide. Thus considering that aspect applicants-accused Gurtej Singh and Balvir Singh are not entitled for the concession of regular bail at this stage and accordingly their regular bail application is dismissed. Police record be returned and bail application be consigned to the record room.
