The Supreme Court on 16.04.2025 in the case of **“The Correspondence, RBANMS Educational Institution Vs. B. Gunashekhar & Anr.” Civil Appeal No. 5200/25** has mandated to all the Courts that if a litigant claims payment of more than Rs.2,00,000/- cash towards any transaction whatsoever, then the same has to be reported to the Income Tax Authorities.
