

Accused present.

Sri. YAB advocate submitted that that the accused is ready to pleads guilty further submitted that accused is poor person and he is earning member of his family and requested to take lenient view on accused and impose minimum fine.

The alleged offences against the accused punishable under Sections 281, U/Sec. 125 (A), U/s 134(a and b) R/w Sec 187, 115 R/W 194 of M.V Act.

Substance of the plea is read over to the Accused and explained Kannada language known to the accused. The accused pleaded guilty for the said offences.

Considering the submission of Sri. YAB advocate and accused, Acting under Section 281 of BNSS, accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Sections 281 of BNS and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.1000/-** for the offence punishable under Section 281 of BNS. In default of the payment the accused is to undergo S.I of 10 days.

Accused is sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.2000/-** for the offence punishable under Section 125 (a) of BNS In default of the payment accused is to undergo S.I of 5 days.

Accused is sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.5000/-** for the offence punishable under Section 134(a & b) R/w 187 of M.V Act. In default of the payment accused is to undergo S.I of 5 days.

Accused is sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.20000/-** for the offence punishable under Section 115 of M.V Act. In default of the payment accused is to undergo S.I of 5 days.

In all, Accused is sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.28000/-**. In default of the payment of the fine amount, Accused is sentenced to undergo S.I of 25 days.

As the accused pleads guilty, thus case is closed.

Since the case is closed thus, the interim custody of the vehicle made absolute.
