Learned PP for the state submitted that no FIR for the offence under section 110, 150 IPC has been registered against the applicant at Police Station Divn.No.8, Jalandhar, rather the proceedings under section 110, 150 Cr.PC have been initiated against the applicant/accused, as so many cases under NDPS Act have been registered against him and he is habitual to commit such like offences and to deal in the Narcotics. In this regard, he also produced on on record the copy of rapat No.41 dated 8.7.2019, under section 110, 150 Cr.P.C, registered at Police Station Divn.No.8, Jalandhar. Since no FIR has been registered against the applicant/accused, so there is no disclosure of any cognizable offence, hence this bail application is rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as infructuous.
