Upon notice, ASI Parminder Singh has come present alongwith record. Heard. In this case, FIR was registered on the statement of Shinder Kaur alleging she received some injuries in a dispute relating to the land. Thereafter, investigation was conducted and in the investigation, vide DDR no.25 dated 23.11.2020, offence U/s 354 IPC was deleted from the FIR. As per police file, co-accused Labh Kaur and Parminder Kaur have already been granted anticipatory bail. As per learned Addl.PP, now again offence U/s 354 IPC has been added in the FIR. From this, it is clearly apparent that it is wish of the police to add the offence and delete the offence on the same evidence, on the basis of which, FIR was registered. Occurrence relates to year 2020 and nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. So, in these circumstances, applicant is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer and in the event of his arrest, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating/ Arresting Officer. Police record be returned forthwith and same be again produced on 17.10.2022.
