ORDER:-

Record of investigation received and perused. Heard.

Vide order dated 05.11.2022, the accused/applicant was granted interim bail with a direction to join the investigation.

Today, ASI Rameshwar Dass, No. 287/SAS Nagar, now posted at Police Station Naya Gaon has appeared and vide separately recorded statement stated that in this case, Kitabo Devi was already arrested on 16.10.2021 and lateron, got released by investigating agency from the concerned on 23.11.2021. Now Kitabo Devi accused is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

From the statement of ASI Rameshwar Dass, it is made out that the accused/ applicant is not required for custodial interrogation. Hence, it would be suffice if she continues joining the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer, hence, in view of the reasons mentioned in the interim bail order dated 05.11.2022 and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the interim bail order dated 05.11.2022 is made absolute

subject to the terms and conditions as mentioned in the said order as well as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. The bail application is allowed accordingly. Record of investigation be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
