This application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Sumit** is placed before me in terms of order No. 18230-18256 Judl /Bail /North /RC /2026, dated 30.04.2026 of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 10.06.2026 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that applicant/accused has not committed any offence as alleged in the above noted FIR. It is further submitted that only allegation made upon the applicant/accused that he caught hold the injured/complainant. It is further submitted that investigation of the present case has been completed qua the accused and he is no more required for custodial interrogation. It is further submitted that no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

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On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 215/2026 has been registered at PS Swaroop Nagar U/s. 110/3(5) BNS. Applicant/accused **Sumit** is in JC since 10.06.2026 i.e. for a period of one month. He is of young age. Investigation qua him has been completed. No useful purpose shall be served by further incarceration of applicant/accused **Sumit**, therefore, it is ordered that applicant/accused **Sumit** be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 20,000/- with one surety** in the like amount **subject to the satisfaction of Ld. JMFC/Ld.Link JMFC/Ld. Duty JMFC as well as following conditions:-**

(i) Applicant/accused is directed not to threaten prosecution witnesses in any manner or tamper with evidence or indulge in any other criminal activity in future;

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(ii) Applicant/accused shall not commit similar offences in future. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the Court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the bail granted to him shall be liable to be cancelled on an application of investigating agency in this regard.

The bail application is disposed of accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case. Application stands disposed of. Bail application file be consigned to record room.
