

**ORDER BELOW EX.1**

1. This is a complaint filed by the complainant for offence punishable under sections 323, 504 and 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
2. After verification, process was issued against accused no. 1 to 4 for offence punishable under sections 323 and 504 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. The case is pending for evidence since 24.08.2023. On perusal of the record, it appears that, the complainant is absent since long. The case is old one, but the complainant failed to adduce evidence.
4. In the circumstances it is provided under section 256 (1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 that on the day appointed for the appearance of the accused or on any day subsequent thereto to which the hearing may be adjourned, if the complainant does not appear, the Court shall acquit the accused, unless for the reasons it thinks fit proper to adjourn the hearing of the case to some other day. On perusal of the roznama, it appears that the complainant is continuously absent. The presence of the complainant today is indispensable to proceed with the case. Therefore, in absence of the complainant, the matter is liable to be dismissed and accused persons are liable to be acquitted vide section 256 (1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:-

ORDER

1. The complaint is dismissed vide section 256 (1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
2. Accused no. 1 to 4 are acquitted from the offence punishable under section 323 and 504 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
