Vide this application, it is submitted that the address already on
the record is last known addresses of the defendant Nos. 2 & 3 where
defendant Nos. 2 & 3 were residing and they are deliberately avoiding service
and they can only be served by way of substituted service through the
publication. Plaintiff has also filed an affidavit with the application. Thus,
considering the affidavit of plaintiff and the reports already on record, this
Court is satisfied that it would be appropriate if defendant Nos. 2 & 3 would
be served through substituted means. **Accordingly, allowing the application,
issue summons for settlement of issues and notice of the application under
Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 CPC to the defendant Nos. 2 & 3 to be published in
newspaper duly circulated at the place where these defendants are known to
be residing lastly, preferably in "Veer Arjun", on filing of PF and deposit of
publication charges.**
