Accused Dev Maan is on bail in person.

Accused Sunil Maan is stated to be without arrest.

At this stage, an application seeking regular bail under section 483 BNSS, is pressed on behalf of the accused Sunil Maan. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for accused Sunil Maan that accused Sunil Maan is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that accused has joined the investigation and investigation has been completed and trial is pending before this court and prayed is made for grant of bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for State duly assisted by the Ld. Counsel for the complainant opposed the bail application of the accused Sunil Maan.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

Accused Sunil Maan has been charge-sheeted without arrest and charge-sheet has already been filed in the present case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, accused **Sunil Maan** is admitted to regular bail under Section 483 BNSS on furnishing bail bond in sum of Rs. 30,000/-

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each with one surety each of the like amount but subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The applicants/accused shall attend the court proceedings regularly.
- (b) That in case of change of his residential addresses, he shall intimate the Court about the same.
- (c) The accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
- (d) The accused shall not indulge into similar offence in the event of release on bail.
- (e) The applicant/accused shall not try to contact or influence the witnesses, in any manner, directly or indirectly.

Accordingly, the bail application is disposed off.

It is clarified that nothing stated herein shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Bail bond/surety bond furnished by accused Sunil Maan. Same is accepted, as per rules.

FSL result is still awaited.

Notice be issued to SHO concerned with direction to take appropriate steps and expedite the proceedings and file the FSL result by the next date of hearing.

Let a separate priority letter be also sent to the Director, FSL in this regard for the NDOH.

Put up for FSL result and for supplementary chargesheet on 24.01.2026.
