File taken up today on an application U/s.439 Cr. P. C for interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Jitender Kumar Maurya @ Munna**.

Reply not filed by the IO.

It is submitted by ld. counsel that the marriage of his real sister is scheduled for 15.02.2023 and the applicant father has already been expired therefore, the presence of applicant/accused is required for particular arrangements for the marriage of his sister and to discharge other ritual liabilities like kanyadaan etc. in his sister's marriage. Ld. counsel has further submitted that applicant/accused has already been granted bail on the same ground by the Court of ld. ASJ-03, THC. He has also given an undertaking in this regard. He has further submitted that as the report has not been filed by the IO today and there are holidays i.e. Saturday and Sunday before next working day and the marriage is scheduled for 15.02.2023, therefore bail be granted considering the order dated 08.02.2023 alongwith my present undertaking.

At this stage, a reply has been filed by ASI Rajesh Kumar on behalf of IO stating that he has verified the fact of marriage of sister of applicant from the IO.

On the other hand, ld. Addl. for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that the offence is serious in nature.

Heard.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances that the marriage of the sister of applicant/accused is scheduled for 15.02.2023 and his father has already expired and his presence is required for making necessary arrangements and performing other rituals, **it is ordered that applicant/accused be released on interim bail from 10.02.2023 to 17.02.2023 on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount. The applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately after the expiry of period of interim bail and concerned jail superintendent shall send his report immediately thereafter.** However, he is further directed not to threaten the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or indulge in any such crime. The applicant/accused shall share his phone's live location as and when required by the IO. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the interim bail granted to him shall be liable to be canceled. The interim bail application is disposed off accordingly.
